

## Privacy Policy

This privacy policy was last modified on February 01, 2018.

Living In The Strange, ("Living In The Strange," "we," or "us") knows that you care how information about you is used and shared. This Privacy Policy explains what information of yours will be collected by Living In The Strange when you use Living In The Strange.com (the "site") and related services (the "Service"), how the information will be used, and how you can control the collection, correction and/or deletion of information. We will not use or share your information with anyone except as described in this Privacy Policy.

### Information We Collect

**User-Provided Information:** You provide us information about yourself, such as your name and e-mail address, when you register with the Service. If you correspond with us by email, we may retain the content of your email messages, your email address and our responses.

**Cookies Information:** When you visit Living In The Strange.com, we may send one or more cookies - a small text file containing a string of alphanumeric characters - to your computer that uniquely identifies your browser and lets Living In The Strange help you log in faster and enhance your navigation through the site. A cookie does not collect personal information about you. Living In The Strange uses both session cookies and persistent cookies. A persistent cookie remains on your hard drive after you close your browser. Persistent cookies may be used by your browser on subsequent visits to the site. Persistent cookies can be removed by following your web browser's directions. A session cookie is temporary and disappears after you close your browser. You can reset your web browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, some features of the Service may not function properly if the ability to accept cookies is disabled.

**Log File Information:** Log file information is automatically reported by your browser each time you access a web page. When you register with or view our site, our hosting servers automatically record certain information that your web browser sends whenever you visit any website. These server logs may include information such as your web request, Internet Protocol ("IP") address, browser type, referring / exit pages and URLs, number of clicks, domain names, landing pages, pages viewed, and other such information. **How We Use Your Information:** We use the personal information you submit to operate, maintain, and provide to you the features and functionality of the Service. Living In The Strange never discloses your personal information to any third party unless you have instructed us to do so.

Any personal information or content that you voluntarily disclose for posting to the Service becomes available to the public via the Service. User Content includes, but is not limited to, reviews, comments, and trivia questions. If you remove User Content, copies may remain viewable in cached and archived pages or if other users have copied or stored your User Content.

By providing Living In The Strange your email address you consent to our using the email address to send you Service-related notices, including any notices required by law, in lieu of communication by postal mail. We may also use your email address to send you other messages, such as newsletters, changes to features of the Service, or special offers. Living In The Strange may use certain information about you and/or your User Content without identifying you as an individual to third parties. We do this for purposes such as analysing how the Service is used, diagnosing service or technical problems, maintaining security, and so forth.

Living In The Strange reserves the right, but has no obligation, to monitor the User Content you post on the site. Living In The Strange has the right to remove any such information or material for any reason or no reason, including without limitation, if in its sole opinion, such information or material violates, or may violate, any applicable law or our Terms of Use Agreement or to protect or defend its rights or property or those of any third party. Living In The Strange also reserves the right to remove information upon the request of any third party.

## **How We Share Your Information**

**Personally Identifiable Information:** Living In The Strange will **not** rent or sell your personally identifiable information to others. Living In The Strange may share your personally identifiable information with third parties solely for the purpose of providing services to you. If we do this, such third parties' use of your information will be bound by this Privacy Policy. We may store personal information in locations outside the direct control of Living In The Strange (for instance, on servers or databases co-located with hosting providers).

Except as otherwise described in this privacy statement, Living In The Strange will not disclose personal information to any third party unless required to do so by law or subpoena or if we believe that such action is necessary to (a) conform to the law, comply with legal process served on us or our affiliates, or investigate, prevent, or take action regarding suspected or actual illegal activities; (b) to enforce our Terms of Use, take precautions against liability, to investigate and defend ourselves against any third-party claims or allegations, to assist government enforcement agencies, or to protect the security or integrity of our site; and (c) to exercise or protect the rights, property, or personal safety of Living In The Strange, our users or others.

**Non-Personally Identifiable Information:** We may share non-personally identifiable information (such as anonymous usage data, referring/exit pages and URLs, platform types, number of clicks, etc.) with interested third parties to help them understand the usage patterns for certain Living In The Strange services.

## **How We Protect Your Information**

Living In The Strange uses commercially reasonable physical, managerial, and technical safeguards to preserve the integrity and security of your personal information. We cannot, however, ensure or warrant the security of any information you transmit to Living In The Strange and you do so at your own risk. Once we receive your transmission of information, Living In The Strange makes commercially reasonable efforts to ensure the security of our systems. However, please note that this is not a guarantee that such information may not be accessed, disclosed, altered, or destroyed by breach of any of our physical, technical, or managerial safeguards.

To protect your privacy and security, we take reasonable steps (such as requesting a unique password) to verify your identity before granting you access to your account. You are responsible for maintaining the secrecy of your unique password and account information, and for controlling access to your email communications from Living In The Strange, at all times.

**Compromise of Personal Information:** In the event that personal information is compromised as a result of a breach of security, Living In The Strange will promptly notify those persons whose personal information has been compromised, in accordance with the notification procedures set forth in this Privacy Policy, or as otherwise required by applicable law.

### **Children's Privacy**

Protecting the privacy of young children is especially important. For that reason, Living In The Strange does not knowingly collect or solicit personal information from anyone under the age of 13 or knowingly allow such persons to register.
